## Job Purpose:

To ensure effective delivery, monitoring and review of all housing landlord services to ensure that they are high quality and responsive, meet the demands and aspirations of tenants and service users, whilst delivering value for money, compliance with best practice, and meeting regulatory and statutory requirements.
- 4. To contribute to meeting political and financial objectives by leading and encouraging the innovation of service delivery methods and improvements through active engagement with councillors, employees, housing providers, trade unions, tenants, service users, communities, health partners, and businesses to improve outcomes.
- 5. To lead, develop and empower colleagues to support their personal achievement and contribution to the delivery of the Council's objectives.
- 6. To contribute to the development of effective partnerships locally, regionally, nationally and internationally to ensure the delivery of Council priorities.

- 7. To fulfil the statutory functions of the Director of Housing & Community Services and be principal adviser to the Council and lead on strategy in this area.
- 8. To promote social inclusion, wellbeing and a whole systems approach to housing provision in the city
- 10. To ensure that the Council fulfils its' statutory duties to safeguard tenants, homeless people, refugees and asylum seekers.
